This addition to the school comprises a Learning Resource Centre and new main entrance for pupils at Ground Floor with two new and one refurbished IT rooms at First Floor, with ancillary offices, medical room, toilets, stores, kitchenette, and lift for disabled. The entrance, foyer and ancillary facilities at Ground level and one IT room at First Floor are formed within the existing structure; all else is new.

Construction is of a steel frame and external cavity masonry with engineering brickwork at Ground level and painted render at First Floor with continuous, generous glazing at both levels. Energy-efficiency is achieved through solar shading and glazing, cross-ventilation, an automatically controlled natural passive ventilation and night-time cooling system, optimum day-lighting with external glare control and internal light-shelf, high thermal insulation and a comprehensive building management and energy control system.
